ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Male student enrolled in good standing in Senior year at a high school located in Hampton Roads, Virginia
- Minimum grade point average of 2.5 on 4.0 scale
- Three (3) Positive Recommendations as follows:
 - 1 from high school teacher
 - 1 from a high school counselor
 - 1 from a character reference

Note: References from family members are not permitted

- Submission of academic transcript from most recent high school must be included in the packet
- Must be accepted to attend accredited four-year institution of higher learning
